
Precautions When Handling Batteries

Batteries do not present a hazard when handled correctly. However, if handled incorrectly or mistreated batteries can quickly become harmful. Please refer to the individual Material Safety Data Sheets for specific details on what actions to take in the event a battery is damaged.

For all batteries the following guidelines should be observed:

- Always Dispose of batteries in accordance with local laws and regulations
- Avoid short circuit
- Do not incinerate batteries
- Observe correct polarity
- Do not disassemble any battery
- Always follow manufacturers' instructions of the equipment concerned for the correct installation of batteries
- Store in cool, dry conditions away from direct sunlight
